HAPPY FEET SPLASH Circular Scarf



Approximate Measurements: 9" length x 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ " width at bottom.

MATERIALS: 2—100G skeins Happy Feet Splash, Color 102 Blue Oreo

Needles/Notions: Circular needle 24" or larger in US Size 6 (4mm), 12 Stitch markers

GAUGE: 22 sts and 24 rows= 4" in garter stitch (k every row) on US Size 6 (4mm) *or size to obtain gauge*. Gauge is not too critical in this pattern.

Begin

(Scarf is worked from the neck down.)

CO 60 stitches and knit 4 rows. Set up pattern on a WS Row as follows: K2, *PM, p2, k1, YO, k1, p2, PM, k4; repeat from * 4 times more, PM, p2, k1, YO, k1, p2, PM, k2—6 sts inc'd. 66 sts.

Row 1: Kf&b; *k to M, make 1, slip M, slip 2 WYIB, k3, slip 2 WYIB, slip M; repeat from * 5 times more, k to last 2 sts, kf&b, k1—8 sts inc'd.

 $\underline{\text{Rows 2 and 4:}}$ *K to M, slip M, p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, slip M; repeat from * 5 times more, k to end.

Row 3: Kf&b; *K to M, slip M, slip 2 WYIB, k3, slip 2

WYIB, slip M, Repeat from * 5 times more, k to last 2 sts, kf&b, k1—2 sts inc'd. Repeat these 4 rows for pattern. You may wish to stop using the M when you become familiar with the pattern. Inc at the beg and end of the row are worked on every RS row; the inc within the pattern are worked on every other RS row.

When you have 20 sts between each garter st section (you will have worked rows 1-4--16 times total and 226 sts on needle), you will inc within the pattern every 8th row, rather than every 4th row as follows:

Row 1: Kf&b; *k to M, make 1, slip M, slip 2 WYIB, k3, slip 2 WYIB, slip M; repeat from * 5 times more, k to last 2 sts, kf&b, k1—8 sts inc'd.

Rows 2, 4, 6: *K to M, slip M, p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, slip M; repeat from * 5 times more, k to end.

Row 3, 5, 7: Kf&b; *K to M, slip M, slip 2 WYIB, k3, slip 2 WYIB, slip M, Repeat from * 5 times more, k to last 2 sts, kf&b, k1—2 sts inc'd.

Cont to inc at the beg and end of each RS row until you have 34 sts between each garter st section (you will have worked rows 1-8--14 times total and 366 sts on needle).

Cont the inc at the beg and end of each RS row, but discontinue all other inc. When you have worked 9" from the beg and have completed a WS row, *work to the inc section. K3 (the 2 sts you have dropped and the next st.) Drop the next st down several rows (It will be dropped to the beg but you may just do a few rows now.) Turn and cable CO 7 sts. Turn and repeat from * to the end. K all sts for 3 rows. Bind



off loosely. Finish pulling down the dropped sts in the middle of the inc sections. Weave in all ends and block if lightly. ©2014 Plymouth Yarn Company. 121114vle. Designed by Sue Hilger.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, cont= continue, inc= increase, K = knit, kf&b= knit into the front and back of next st, Make 1= With the left hand needle pick up the bar between the stitch just worked and the next stitch and knit into the back loop, mm= millimeter, PM= place marker, RS= right side, st(s) = stitch(es), st= stitch, WS= wrong side, WYIB= With yarn in back, YO= after a knit stitch, bring he yarn to the front, lay it across the right hand needle and knit into the next stitch
