Saturday, June 1st:

11:00 am – Beginning Crochet Class

Deborah Broome loves to teach anyone who wants to learn to crochet. Cost is \$50 and includes yarn, hook, book, and personal instruction for **3 one-hour classes**. In Part One you will learn to make a chain and single crochet a coaster, then in Part Two you'll learn to crochet in a circle and make a coaster and cozy. Part Three will teach you to double crochet and make a wonderful wash cloth/dish rag. Parts 2 and 3 will be scheduled upon completion of Part 1.

1:00 pm – Step Up Learning

This is a follow-up to the Beginning Knitting Classes. Students will work on a simple washcloth pattern and learn how to increase and decrease stitches. This will help you move on to knitting hats and other garments. **Class is \$10.00**; you will need to bring your US8 needle. **All class supplies are 15% off on the day of the class.**

Deb will show you techniques to crochet Granny Squares. You will be making fun, seasonal washcloths out of cotton yarn each month. This is great for beginners who can chain, single and double crochet. **Class is \$10.00, and you get 15% off class supplies on the day of the class.**
