Saturday, August 3rd:

10:30 am - Beginning Knitting

Angela Childress is the teacher. Cost is \$75 and includes yarn, book, needles, accessories and personal instruction for 3 one-hour classes. In Part One, you will learn to cast on and knit a coaster. Part Two will teach you how to bind-off and purl a coaster, and Part Three will cover how to make a pattern using the knit and purl stitch. Parts 2 and 3 will be scheduled upon completion of Part 1.

1:00 pm – Drop Spindle Class

Lori Hall will be teaching. Cost is \$30 and includes personal instruction for 3 one-hour classes. In Part One, you will learn to use your drop spindle and spin pencil roving. In Part Two you will learn to ply the pencil roving you spun, and how to skein the yarn and measure the length. Part Three will cover how to prepare roving by stripping and drafting. Parts 2 and 3 will be scheduled upon completion of Part 1.

Thursday, August 8th:

10:30 am – Rigid Heddle Loom Weaving Class

Jane Deason will have rigid heddle looms warped and ready for you to learn to weave and complete a scarf. This quick class will help you understand the components of weaving. Cost is \$55 and includes all supplies needed to make a 5-foot scarf.

11:00 am – Crochet Earrings

Deborah Broome will help you learn to crochet with thread and make beautiful earrings. This is great for beginners who can chain, single and double crochet. Class is \$10.00, and you get 15% off class supplies on the day of the class.

2:00 pm – Beyond Beginning Spinning:

This class is designed to take you beyond beginning spinning. Jane Deason of Angora Jane will show you how to spin using different techniques to perfect your skill. In August she will teach you to spin to a standard. Class cost is \$25; wheel rental is \$10 extra. Must be knowledgeable with spinning on a wheel.

11:00 am - Granny Square Class with Deb

Deb will show you techniques to crochet Granny Squares. You will be making fun, seasonal washcloths out of cotton yarn each month. This is great for beginners who can chain, single and double crochet. Class is \$10.00, and you get 15% off class supplies on the day of the class.

Jane Deason of Angora Jane is going to teach us all about different types of wool, how to process wool on a budget, and more. 10:30 am - Cock-Eyed Cowl:

Lori will teach you how to knit a cowl that has an illusion that will make your head tilt. This is a quick, easy cowl that will make great holiday gifts. We will be using a new fall yarn for this class. Class includes personal instruction and pattern. Class is \$10.00, and you will receive 15% off class supplies on the day of the class.

11:00 am – Tunisian Crochet with Deb:

Come learn different Tunisian stitches with Deborah Broome. Deb teaches a new stitch each month while you make washcloths. You can use these stitches to make wonderful blankets and/or beautiful garments. If you are interested in expanding your crochet talents, then take the next step and learn different Tunisian stitches. Class is \$10.00, and you will receive 15% off class supplies on the day of the class.

1:00 pm – Tri-Loom Weaving:

Jane is teaching us how to make shawls using a Triangular loom. These looms are handmade and simple to use once you learn the process. This is a 3-hour class and will fill up quickly, so sign up soon. Class cost is \$60.00 and includes everything you need to make a shawl.

2:00 pm – Multnomah Shawl:

This pattern is one of the most popular patterns on Ravelry with over 10,000 projects, and more projects continue to be knit with it every year! Angela Childress, of That's Stitchtastic, will help you improve your knitting skills while working this satisfying pattern. Angela will be teaching you the "Bar Increase", which is a type of increase used widely by knitwear designers. Class is \$20.00, and you will receive 15% off class supplies on the day of the class.
